Explanation and requirements for applicant:

- Practicing Catholic (including regular Mass attendance)
- Member of the Pilgrim Cluster parishes (Alton, Granville, Hospers)
- Graduating senior
- Write an essay (no more than one page) on how faith has helped you in a time of adversity.
- List your personal involvement in your church, school & community.
- Pastor (or other person) will verify participation in faith-related activities if needed.

One scholarship will be given. Scholarship is for \$600 (or \$900 if child graduates from a Catholic high school **and** father is a member of KC Council #3810).

Scholarship is given the second semester of the first year of college.
Student must provide verification of attendance for the first semester.
Student must also provide proof of intention (class schedule) to attend second semester.

Three members of the Knights of Columbus council will make the determination of the winner(s). The applicants will remain anonymous until the winner is chosen.

Certificate will be presented by Grand Knight or member of the Knights of Columbus.
