## First Communion and First Reconciliation Class

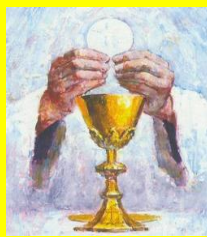
This year, we are holding a First Holy Communion and First Reconciliation Meeting at the beginning of the year rather than waiting until we are almost through the 2018-2019 year.

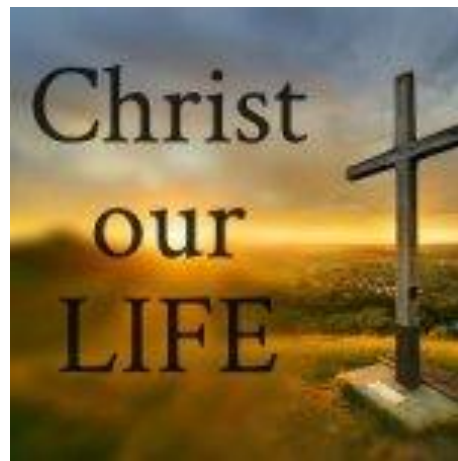
First Reconciliation will be 01/09/2019 @ 6:30 p.m. at the St. Joseph Catholic Church in Granville.
